For those family members who are unable to observe your dancer in class, this section of our newsletter will give you an overview of what they are doing and learning in class each month and information that faculty would like for parents to know. We're looking forward to the #DANCEISLIFE RECITAL, happening on June 4, 2016!

MISS CHERYL

We have started our recital pieces in all of our classes. However, we continue to focus on the training that brings the element of perfection to combinations and dances. So whether they are participating in the recital or not, they are still very much involved in class and training hard! I am really challenging the dancers with difficult technical steps and rhythms as well as combinations that we are incorporating into our pieces we work on. Class has really become fun and exciting to teach and see the dancers work through the obstacles placed before them. I love when they grasp "the new." It fills my cup! Good work dancers!

⊘MR. BEN

Musical Theater: We have had a lot of fun in Musical Theater this month! With a quick review of all of the shows we covered in February (*Grease, Fiddler on the Roof, Once on This Island,* and *Pippin*) to round out the month, we are now looking forward into March. This month, we'll be looking at more contemporary pieces from the 2010s: *Kinky Boots* and Disney's *Newsies*. We also will be doing some original choreography ourselves to explore and learn how dancing can help tell the story of a musical as much as the music and dialogue can.

MISS KERI

*Please have the girls dressed in proper attire: pink footed tights, black leotard, and hair in a bun or pulled back from the face. Thank you!

Pre-Ballet: We will focus on moving in time with the music, turn out, proper alignment and memorizing or ballet terminology. We will continue working on more difficult combinations since these students perform very well, are always 'present', and are progressing fast.

Pointe: We will continue to strengthen the foot and ankle as well as perfecting the proper body placement to continue working on our pirouettes en pointe.

Ballet I: We will continue to follow a structured syllabus; increasing terminology, especially at barre. Pirouettes and proper foot placement will be our focus (which we will always focus on proper placement). Also we will learn the importance of preparation while going across the floor.

Ballet II: More difficult combinations and new allegro terminology will be presented. We will continue on working on proper body alignment and pirouettes. I will be pushing to perfect the basics and laying the foundation to work on more complex combinations.

Ballet III: I will be focusing on a higher level training for those who want to advance their dancing skills. We will continue to follow a structured syllabus designed to increase technical knowledge and understanding of classical ballet.

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Ballet IV: A greater emphasis will be placed on artistry, movement, quality, and performance. I am encouraging this group to own their dancing, to feel the music and the steps as an expression of themselves, which they are doing great.

☼ MISS AMANDA

Pre Tap: This month we have been working on the recital dance, it's coming along great. We have been working on drawbacks, the military time step, and riffs. A big thing we have been working on is memorizing the steps.

Jazz I: This month we have been working on the recital dance, the girls look great. We have been working on pirouettes, chainé turns, and our leaps across the floor.

Hip Hop I: This month we have been working our recital dance, the kids love it. We have been working on a new exercise to help with our "popping."

☼ MISS CHARITY

Jazz II: We have begun our recital dance. We are dancing to Mercy, by Duffy. The girls are doing great in learning the choreography!

Lyrical/Contemporary IV: We have begun our recital dance. We are dancing to Wrecking Ball, by Miley Cyrus. Intense choreography and small solo parts for all!

Jazz III: We have begun our recital dance. We are dancing to Exes and Ohs, by Elle King. The staging is complex in working with multiple groups doing various formations and use of prop. Great start!

Lyrical/Contemporary II: We have begun our recital dance. We are dancing to Shake it Off, by Us the Duo. The dancers are responsible for learning and remembering their dance and need to be practicing outside of the class as well. They are working on partnering and contemporary style movement.

Combo II: We have begun our recital dances. We are dancing to Joy for tap and Every Girl Can Be a Princess for ballet. The girls are doing great in learning the dances and committing them to memory!

Tap I: We have begun our recital dance. We are dancing to Blue Jeans by Jesse James. The tap steps are advanced for beginning tap and they are doing wonderfully at learning them and remembering them. Lots of spunk and style in this class!

Leaps & Turns: We have begun our recital dance. We are dancing to a (clean) mix of Cool for the Summer by Demi Lovato and California Gurls by Katy Perry. There are three classes that will be combined for the recital so patterning and staging are complex. Dancers MUST bring a towel to class EVERY week. Dates for additional rehearsals, so that all three classes can practice together, will be posted shortly.

MISS MARIA

Team Intermediate/Advanced Acro: We have started to work on a little bit more complex skills such as back handsprings as well as aerials. Along with continuously building our acro skills, we have started to put our recital piece together.

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☼ MISS TAMMY

Tween and Teen Hip Hop: We are working on choreography but putting "style" into the choreography as well. I always push the students to do new things and these students are loving it! It's amazing to see the smiles and confidence that comes along with achieving something new and exciting. We continue to work on body isolations, dancing "down into the floor" (opposed to on top of it) tricks, building stamina etc. but most of all, we continue to have fun!

Lyrical I: This amazing class is working on core strength, grace, understanding how to "match' your music with your body movement/emotion and technique. These little ladies work very well together and love the routine they'll perform at the recital. I can't express how wonderful it is to have students that are eager to learn! Thanks ladies!
